SouthWest Transit Commission Names New Officers and has New Member

Eden Prairie, MN – February 15, 2010 – The SouthWest Transit Commission, the governing body of the transit system that serves Eden Prairie, Chanhassen and Chaska has named new officers and also has a new representative. The Commission is comprised of seven members, an elected official from each of the three cities, an appointed member from each of the cities and a Rider Representative.

The Commission appointed Tom Furlong, the Mayor of Chanhassen as Chair; Nancy Tyra-Lukens, the appointed member from Eden Prairie, as Vice-Chair; and Greg Boe, Chaska council member, as Secretary/Treasurer for the SouthWest Transit Commission.

The City of Chaska reappointed Jennifer Wolff as its resident member. Eden Prairie council member Jon Duckstad was appointed to another term on the Commission. Chanhassen appointed a new person, Jody Collis King, to a three year term on the Commission. The Commission then reappointed Bjarne Henderson to another term as Rider Representative.
